Currently, most of the sales are in the US & Canada. The business is profitable and has more than doubled sales since Alfa Laval acquired it in 2007. Job Description

A key member of the accounting staff reporting directly to the Financial Controller. Major focus of responsibilities will be in the manufacturing job costing area, supports line management in analysis and decision-making needs, KPI / P&L monitoring, both ad hoc and routine; however, there will be other functions as well.

Cost accountants at this level need solid organizational, communication, problem-solving and research abilities. Companies also seek strong technology expertise, including proficiency with Microsoft Excel, queries and experience with enterprise resource planning (ERP) systems. A bachelor's degree in accounting or finance is required.

- Manages Cost Update process; and KPI reporting.
- Develop MS-SQL queries and procedures, create custom reports, and modify ERP data to enhance organizational productivity.
- Supports Production Management Team.
- Work closely with other departments to act and supply information to keep business activities flowing smoothly to completion – areas such as working with Fairview Plant Manager on updating routings and times and supporting sales with accurate cost data by product.
